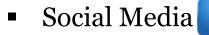

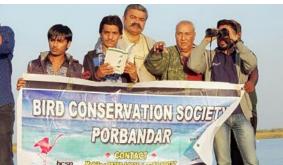

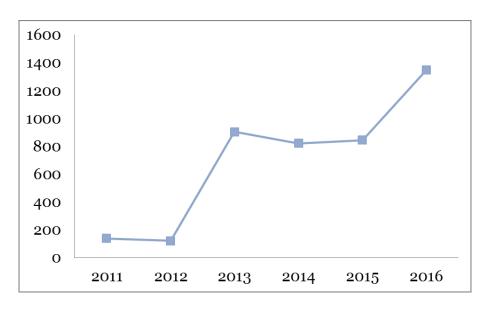






# Reporting World Wetlands Day

- Mailing list developed will facilitate communication with event organizers



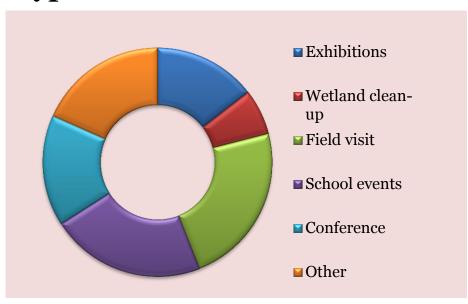

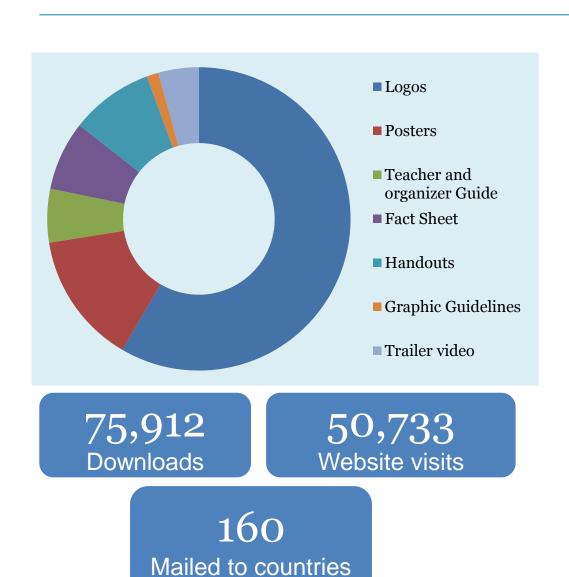

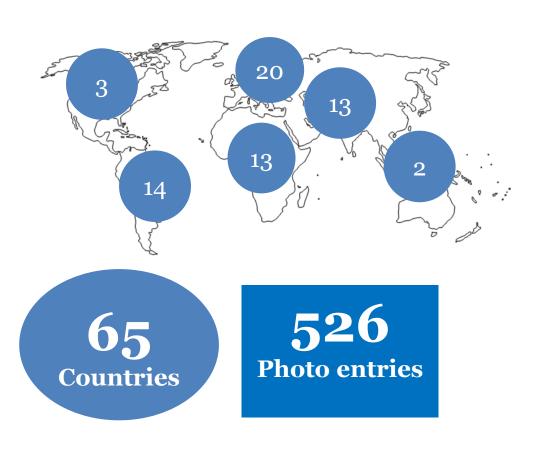




## **Wetlands Youth Photo Contest 2016**

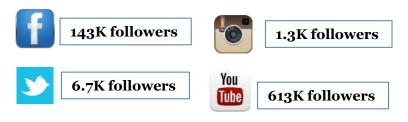

  - o Partner platforms vital to outreach to more audiences

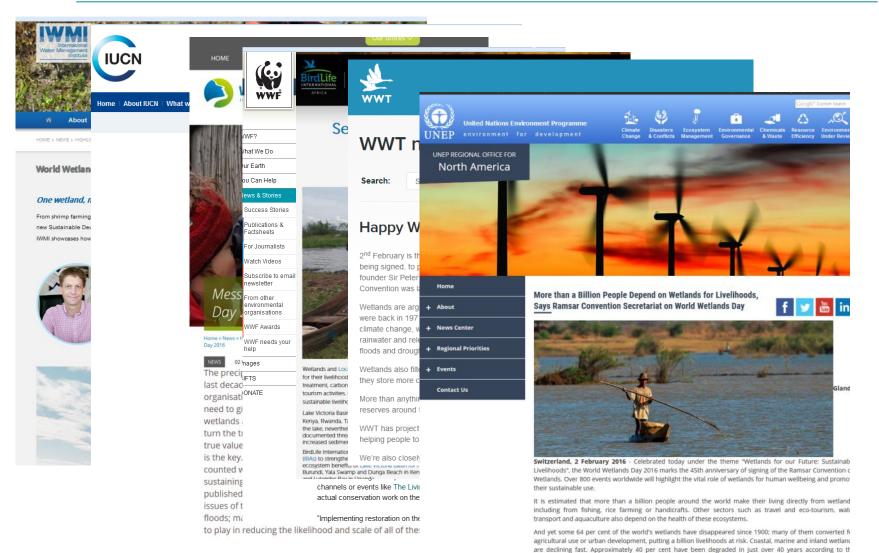

Potential reach 2016



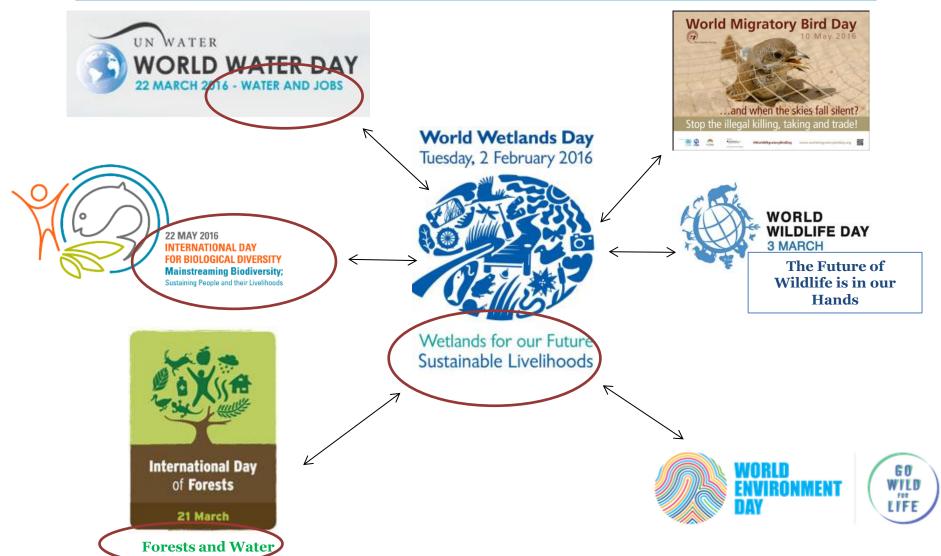


Wetland Extent Trend and this decline is continuing at an accelerated rate of 1.5 per cent annually.



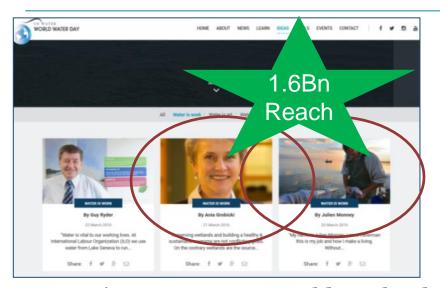

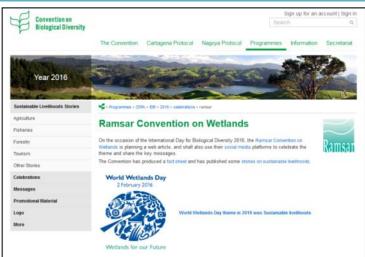

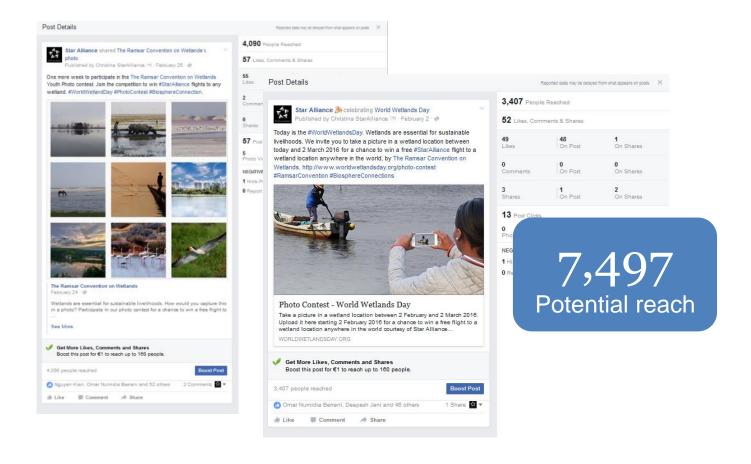
