

## Workplan of the Secretariat for 2023-2025

- 1. The integrated Annual Plan for 2023 and Triennial Plan for 2023-2025 attached in Annex 1 (hereafter referred to as the "Secretariat Workplan") follows the structure approved by the Standing Committee in Decision SC54-10 and used for the Secretariat Workplan for 2019-2022 approved by the Standing Committee in Decision SC57-21. It is structured around the seven core functions of the Secretariat and sets out principal activities and corresponding annual and triennial indicators for each, together with indicative lead responsibilities and principal funding source (i.e. core, non-core or other).
- 2. As for the preceding triennium, the Secretariat Workplan was drafted through an extensive, participative process, led by the Senior Management Team but with the involvement of all Secretariat staff. An externally facilitated, in-person workplanning workshop was held at the office of the Secretariat in Gland from 6 to 9 March 2023. The workshop also included a rigorous review of Secretariat progress against the previous Triennial Plan, which enabled staff to draw conclusions to inform the drafting of the Triennial Plan for 2023-2025. The outcomes of that workshop are reflected in the final draft.
- 3. The final draft has integrated new and amended mandates arising from the Resolutions of the 14th meeting of the Conference of the Contracting Parties (COP14), that instruct, request, or otherwise direct the Secretariat to undertake specific tasks.
- 4. The number of tasks assigned to the Secretariat by Contracting Parties continues to grow significantly, whilst the resources for implementation remain highly constrained. This is reflected in an increasing gap between the expectations of Parties on one hand and the Secretariat's capacity to deliver on the other.
