Please check your need for a Swiss visa or a transit visa for any stopovers en route to Switzerland. Visa processing may take up to four weeks, it is therefore recommended contacting your nearest Swiss Embassy as early as possible.

The Secretariat will provide **sponsored** participants requiring a Schengen Visa with insurance for emergency medical treatment and accidents. This insurance does not cover pre-existing treatment for medical conditions.

Travel in Switzerland

Participants are responsible for arranging their own travel arrangements, and covering associated costs.

From Geneva Airport to your hotel (Nyon)

A direct train service connects Geneva Airport to Nyon and Gland.

Upon arrival at the airport, follow signs to the "Gare CFF/SBB" in the Arrival Hall, and proceed to the railway station's ticket hall.

You can purchase your ticket from a ticket machine with Swiss francs (CHF) or a credit/debit card. As of January 2023, a one-way ticket to Nyon costs CHF 15 (2nd class).

Timetables displaying train schedules are located above the escalators leading down to the train platforms. Ensure you take a train stopping in Nyon. Direct trains depart at 19 and 40 minutes past every hour, arriving in Nyon 24 minutes later. Timetables are available here.

From Nyon to the Secretariat headquarters in Gland

The journey from Nyon to Gland is a four-minute, one-stop train ride. Trains depart Nyon (direction Lausanne) in the mornings at 10 and 36 minutes past every hour. In the evenings, trains leave Gland for Nyon (direction Genève) at 21 and 50 minutes past the hour.

You can request the Carte Explore from your hotel for the duration of your stay in Switzerland. It entitles you to free travel by bus or train in all Mobilis zones in the Nyon district, covering Gland area.

The Secretariat headquarters are in the <u>Conservation Centre</u> shared with IUCN at Rue Mauverney 28, 1196 Gland. It is 10 minute walk from the Gland railway station.

The currency used in Switzerland is Swiss francs (CHF). Sponsored participants will receive a daily substance allowance (DSA) on the first day of the meeting. Exchange services are not available during weekends in Nyon or Gland.

Electric plugs and adapters

In Switzerland, the electrical current is 220 Volts, 50 Hertz. Participants are advised to bring an adapters and converters for charging their electronic devices. The types of sockets used in Switzerland are illustrated below.
