**Letter of Designation of Transboundary Ramsar site Iron Gates Natural Park – Djerdap  
between Romania and the Republic of Serbia**

Pursuant to Article 5 of the Ramsar Convention, recognizing that designation of transboundary Ramsar sites allow improved management and conservation status of wildlife and their habitats in the wetlands that extend national boundaries and development of joint research programmes, exchange of knowledge and information, we jointly request Secretariat of the Ramsar Convention to register the following wetland site as Transboundary Ramsar Site between Romania and the Republic of Serbia:

**Iron Gates Natural Park – Djerdap**
