- Based on a 3 years' agreement (actual: 2007-2010)
- > 250'000.- Euros per year
- Budget and program developed on a 1 year basis with the regional teams and follows 3 axes
- Currently negotiating 2011-2014 MoU

 - Review all types of wetlands and importance on roles in carbon storage



- UN-HABITAT jointly developing policy paper and guidance for management of urban wetlands (with STRP)
- Uruguay project- Remove site from Montreux record





- > A project based international programme with local partners
- A total amount of 620'000.- Euros until June 2011
- > 3 current projects in the world: Argentina, Thailand, Nepal








Outputs:

Objective:

- Capitalize on the essential role of wetlands in carbon capturemangroves.
- Support programs to store carbon by restoring wetlands.

Main work of Ramsar:

- Facilitating the development of a wetland carbon measurment and offset methodology
- Inform and get the agreement of the involved countries for new projects
- **2009:** Wetcarbon workshop Danone Senegal project
- **2010:** Continue methodology research Develop 1 or 2 new projects

- Regional dynamic with Evian-Danone offices (Japan, Thailand, Argentina, United Arab Emirates)
- Participation and involvment of the Ramsar regional teams (budget and activities, workshops)
- Coordination and more visibility of the partnership in meetings, etc.
- **Communication** on the website and for the public



- Not the same « **rythm** » of work
- Need to have a focal point on both side, **time demanding**
- Develop exchanges of competences when possible
- Decisions and engagements must be **in a long term** and respected
- Reflexion on how to continue to influence the private sector for behaviour's change
