


SDGs best chance to mainstream wetlands in development

A unique opportunity to raise the profile of wetlands

Ramsar Convention network has body of knowledge & experience as well as political access:

- ➤ Coordinated lobby on SDG texts prior to the summit addressing the gaps in targets and indicators on wetlands
- > Press for financing systems that intertwine investments for environment with development
- ➤ Catalyse action for wetlands linked to SDGs globally, regionally and nationally → through partnerships, dialogue and capacity building; use of Ramsar guidance
