Dear Mr. Secretary General,

To fulfil the commitments made by the two countries in their national reports submitted to the 9<sup>th</sup> Conference of the Contracting Parties of the Convention on Wetlands (Ramsar, Iran, 1971), we, the undersigned persons in charge of nature conservation of the Republic of Hungary and the Slovak Republic, in accordance with *Article 5* of the text of the Convention on Wetlands and with Resolution VII. 19 on Guidelines on international cooperation under the Ramsar Convention, hereby propose to designate the following two sites, already listed on the List of Wetlands of International Importance, as transboundary sites, in order to facilitate harmonising the management of this shared wetland:

(in English Ipoly valley)
RS No. 1093
Hungarian part
2 227.6 hectares

Poiplie

RS No. 930 Slovak part 410.87 hectares

We hope that this effective and fruitful cooperation between Slovakia and Hungary in the field of nature conservation will be appreciated by the international community.
