**Subject: Designation of a Transboundary Wetland of International Importance by the Czech Republic and the Republic of Poland**

in accordance with Article 5 of the Convention on Wetlands and Resolution VII.19 on Guidelines for international cooperation under the Ramsar Convention, acting jointly with Ministry of the Environment of the Czech Republic, I propose to designate the following already designated Ramsar sites:

No. 637 Krkonoská rašelinište (Krkonose mountains mires) – 2/11/93

No. 1566 Subalpine peatbogs in Karkonosze Mountains - 29/10/02

as a Transboundary Ramsar Site: “Krkonose/Karkonosze subalpine peatbogs”, in order to facilitate the management of this shared wetlands.

I hope that this effective cooperation between Poland and Czech Republic in the field of nature conservation will be appreciated by the international community.
