Day 2: Sightseeing Tour of Tbilisi

Day 3: Tbilisi - David Gareja – Gurjaani - Tsinandali (230 km, 4 hours)

Day 4: Tsinandali – Telavi – Signagi - Tbilisi (280 km, 3-4 hours)
