

2nd February 2010 World Wetlands Day in Bulgaria

Bulgaria is among the first Parties to the Ramsar Convention on Wetlands, which was adopted on 2nd February 1971 in Ramsar, Iran.

In List of Wetlands of International Importance, Bulgaria is represented with 10 wetlands, covered 20 306 hectares – “Atanasovsko Lake”, “Belene Islands Complex”, “Durankulak Lake”, “Ibisha Islands”, “Lake Shabla”, “Poda”, “Pomorie Wetland Complex”, “Ropotamo Complex”, “Srebarna”, “Vaya Lake”.

The World Wetlands Day in Bulgaria was celebrated with campaigns over the country, organized by the regional structures of the Ministry of Environment and Water and directed to kindergartens, schools and universities, and including open lessons, exhibitions, presentations, activities of different environmental school clubs, open doors days in the Central Laboratory of General Ecology of the Bulgarian Academy of Sciences, etc.
