We are pleased to inform you that the Sultanate of Oman has organized a special event to participate in the activities of World Wetland's Day: Forests for Water and Wetlands on February 2nd 2011 by launching the Mangrove Trees Transplantation Campaign, where a total of 1,000 mangrove seedlings were transplanted at Al-Qurm Nature Park Reserve, as well as a cleaning campaign for the Reserve with the contribution of 200 participants from various local institutions and organizations (Omani Woman's Society in Muscat, Environment Society of Oman, Directorate-General of Education in Muscat – Scouts and Guides, The American School and Al-Khansa'a Private School).
