- STRP products easily accessible to wetland managers and national focal points
- STRP products in user-friendly language, style and translations
- better share of information, especially best practice case studies
- short briefing notes targeted to specific audiences
- completing tasks already in hand, not invest in issues with unknown outcomes
- improve two-way linkages between regional initiatives and STRP
- face-to-face meetings of NFPs, such as in Austria 2007 and South Africa 2011
- work on climate change with other institutions, economics of ecosystem services, inventory and RS information management
- co-financing and joint work with EU, UNESCO, development agencies, foundations
- more social science expertise, work on communities benefit from wetlands, better networking at regional level

- undertake common communication and outreach activities
