- simple guidance on how the wetland should be managed now that it is a Ramsar site, including measuring the effectiveness of their management
- to call on national authorities to put in place on the job training for protected area staff, especially on wetland management

Way Forward

Needs of the site managers (thru a Resolution by the STRP)

- hold annual meetings of the national site managers to share experiences
- call on national authorities to review their funding arrangements for Ramsar sites and put in place mechanisms for the site to be adequately funded
