
## Initial Strategic Plan Working Group thinking

#### Scope:

- Not just for Ramsar but for all those using/working with wetlands and including the need for cross-sectoral recognition of wetland services
- wetlands and water, ecosystems (and their services) and people (including their culture);
- Goals: Continue with the current SP 5 Goals (concerning Wise use, Ramsar Sites etc.) or have a different focus aimed at all wetlands and water stakeholders;
- Title: "Strategic Plan for wetlands and water-related ecosystems and their services" or "Strategic Plan for wetlands and water"?
- Duration: 2015-2021 (two triennia)
- Structure: Two part document starting with a discussion on wetlands and water for the broad audience, and then a second part for the Ramsar family on implementation
- Alignment with other MEAs: e.g. Aichi Targets, new CMS Strategic Plan being developed, other processes

- Update the template for date collection and presentation for the national wetland inventory (collaboration with ACB);
- Opportunities for STRP members to provide on the ground technical assistance to CP's (e.g. Prof. Gardner)
- Review of sustainable financing mechanism for use at Ramsar Sites (collection of case studies)
- Review methodologies for conducting rapid assessment of ecosystem services provided by wetland sites and valuation of those services, and trial of selected methodologies at pilot Ramsar Sites; (collection of case studies)
  - Review and identify methodologies for tracking management effectiveness of Ramsar Sites, and trial of selected methodologies at pilot Ramsar Sites; (collection of case studies)
  - Development of standard manual for site management (collaboration with ACB, IUCN, WWF etc)
- Assist CP's in developing national courses on PA management
